

Information Security Policy Statement

The Directors recognise the importance of developing and implementing an Information Security Management System (ISMS). To protect business information assets within Print Image Network from all threats, whether internal or external, deliberate or accidental, and also to demonstrate the commitment we have towards our customers' information security.

Print Image Network's ISMS programme is founded on the British Standard BS ISO/IEC 27001:2013, published by the BSi.

Consistent with the requirements of the above standard, we have:

- Produced control documents to define requirements for a management systems approach to information security management (ISM), based on industry best practices.
- Ensured that information is only accessible to authorised persons from within or outside the company and minimise damage by preventing and reducing the impact of security incidents.
- Taken steps to ensure that Confidentiality, Integrity and Availability of information is maintained throughout business functions and processes.
- Established a risk assessment methodology to identify and control the security of business information meeting legal and regulatory requirements.
- Demonstrated successful implementation of this management system to assure all interested parties to the business that an appropriate information security management system is in place.

These specific requirements for setting up and managing an effective information security management system emphasise Print Image Network's commitment to:

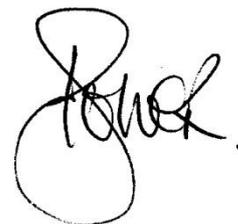
- Understanding information security needs and the necessity of establishing policy and objectives for information security;
- Implementing and operating controls and measures for managing an organisation's overall information security risk;
- Monitoring and reviewing the performance and effectiveness of the ISMS; and
- Continual improvement based on objective measurement.

It is the policy of Print Image Network to conduct a management review of the ISMS annually or when significant changes take place to ensure the system meets the requirements of all stakeholders and compliance to the ISO 27001 standard.

The Managing Director has overall responsibility for maintaining this Policy and providing guidance on its implementation. All managers are directly responsible for ensuring that policies and procedures are followed within their business areas. It is the responsibility of each employee to adhere to the business ISMS policies and procedures.
